

MEASURES TO COMBAT COVID-19

TO SAFEGUARD PATIENTS, THEIR ATTENDANTS AND STAFF, WE HAVE IMPLEMENTED COMPREHENSIVE HYGIENE MEASURES ACROSS THE HOSPITAL BASED ON THE MOHFW ADVISORY AND GUIDELINES.

- Ongoing sensitization of all staff, patients and their families to the protocols prescribed.
- Additional, frequent sanitization of all areas, especially where there is high traffic.
- All patients and attendants are advised to use the alcohol-based hand sanitizers at the main entrance. Additionally, all are advised to wash their hands frequently with soap and water and also make use of the hand sanitizers, which have been conveniently placed throughout the hospital.
- Body temperature screening implemented at main entrance of the hospital, for all patients, attendants and staff.
- Additional screening protocols put in place for high risk groups.
- Crowds are being minimized by limiting the number of visitors to the hospital. Only one attendant allowed per patient in the outpatient lobby. Restrictions also in place for inpatient attendants.
- Patients are requested to self-declare foreign travel, and appropriate additional screening measures in place.
- All new international patients directed through the ER entrance for travel and medical screening.
- Usage of masks advised only for those individuals who are taking care of a person with suspected 2019-nCoV infection, or for those who are coughing and/ or sneezing.

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
